Food 4 Less Asks Customers to Check Freezers at Home for Ground Beef Products Recalled Due to Possible Health Risk

Food 4 Less stores in Illinois and Indiana are recalling select store-brand and store-packaged beef products because the beef was supplied by JBS Swift Beef Co. and may be contaminated with *E. coli* O157:H7.

Food 4 Less asks customers to carefully check their freezers at home for store-brand and store-packaged ground beef with sell-by dates from April 27 to June 1, 2009. These items include ground beef products in foam tray packages wrapped in clear cellophane with the following UPCs:

Customers who have any of these recalled items should not consume the products and should return them to a store for a full refund or replacement. Thank you.
