**Fry's Asks Customers to Check Freezers at Home for Beef Products  
Recalled Due to Possible Health Risk**

Fry's Food and Drug Stores is recalling select store-brand and store-packaged beef products because the beef was supplied by JBS Swift Beef Co. and may be contaminated with *E. coli* O157:H7.

Fry's asks customers to carefully check their freezers at home for store-brand and store-packaged ground beef with sell-by dates from April 27 to June 1, 2009. These items include beef products in foam tray packages wrapped in clear cellophane with the following UPCs:
